## Scholarship Guidelines

First Congregational UCC of River Falls offers three different types of Scholarships:

### High School Senior Scholarship

This scholarship is for graduating High School seniors who are attending an accredited institution of higher education. It may be applied for only once in the spring. Applicants must complete the entire form including an essay along with a letter of recommendation by an individual that can attest to his/her academic performance.

### Continuing Education Scholarship

This scholarship is for higher education students who are continuing to pursue a degree at either the undergraduate or graduate level. It may be applied for up to three times for undergraduate students and up to two times for graduate students. These scholarships must be returned by the second Sunday of May for the next academic school year.

### Spiritual Growth Scholarship

Spiritual Growth Scholarships are awarded for Lay Academy, church trips, camps and other denominational events sponsored by First Congregational. Spiritual Growth Scholarships will be capped at a maximum of \$200 per application. These scholarships may be applied for at any time of the year. An applicant is limited to receiving three awards for the same activity with the exception of volunteers for youth mission trips. Family camp scholarships are limited to three individuals per family.

## Guidelines for All Scholarship Applications:

An applicant for these scholarships must be a member of First Congregational United Church of Christ in River Falls and must have committed some service to this church or some other church in the last calendar year.

The Scholarship Committee will annually set the amount to be dispersed. Scholarships will be granted based on applicant's information and available funds.
